What is a GSM intercom?

- A GSM intercom is a wireless intercom that allows you to call out to landline and mobile phones. The unit takes a standard pre-paid or contracted SIM card, which then allows you to speak with people at your gate with the use of a mobile phone. The intercom acknowledges certain text strings in order to program the unit. You also have the benefits of programming up the unit via installer and end user apps. A GSM intercom is a no hassle, wire-free intercom perfect for gate installs.



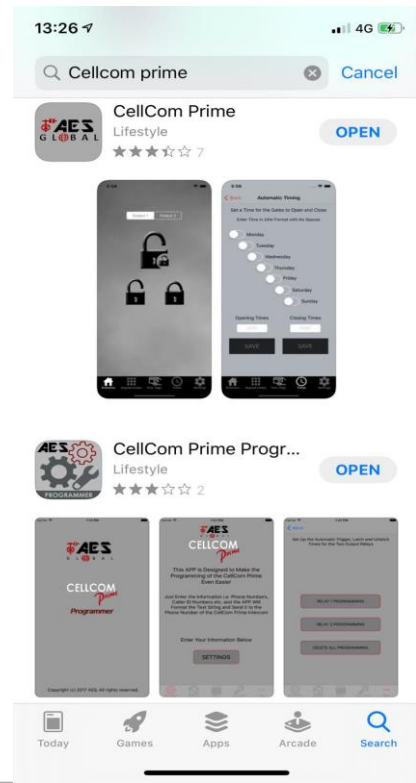


Features & Benefits of an AES GSM intercom

Installer and End User apps for programming and maintaining the system.

- Why is this important?

This is important as it allows different levels of control over the system. The installer app (Cellcom Prime Programmer) allows full access for the installer to program whatever they may need. The End user app (Cellcom Prime) gives the end user partial control over the system such as opening and latching functionality and keypad programming.





Features & Benefits of an AES GSM intercom

Remote keypad and proximity programming

- What is this?

This allows both the installer and end user to remotely add keycodes and proximity cards into the system via the use of the programming apps. We have taken this one step further and allows time-restricted and temporary proximity and pin access.

- Why is this important?

This is a huge time saver as you don't require to be local to the intercom to add new users' codes/cards. With the use of time-restricted and temporary codes, this allows for additional security and begins to touch into the commercial market.





Features & Benefits of an AES GSM intercom

Do Not Disturb & Out of Hours

- What is this?

The Do Not Disturb functionality allows you to select certain periods of the day where you do not want to receive an incoming call from the intercom. Out of hours is an extension to this feature where it allows to call out to a different number in this set period.

- Why is this important?

This is important as you may live in an area that receives a lot of traffic (near a pub or a shop) that may attract some unwanted visitors at night-time. The out of hours can be used for a commercial property that can call out to a security guard/company during the business's out of hours.

Features & Benefits of an AES GSM intercom

2 relays

-What is this?

With all our GSM range, you have 2 normally open/normally closed relays. This means you can operate 2 gates from 1 intercom. These relays trigger, latch and unlatch the gates from the app and using DTMF.

-Why is this important?

This is majorly important residentially as most end users would require gates for car and pedestrian access. With the AES range, this isn't a problem and can work with any automation brand. The latching feature of both relays means that you can keep your gate open if you have visitors around and don't want to keep triggering the gates. With the AES intercom, you can also set 'auto-relay times'





Features & Benefits of an AES GSM intercom

AES offer SIM cards

-What does this mean?

With every GSM intercom we send out, you will receive a SIM card as part of the kit. This SIM card is a Vodafone contracted SIM that allows the installer to make money back on their installs once activated.

- How does this benefit me?

A GSM intercom requires a SIM card to work so you might as well make some money from them! You can earn £1 on every SIM card activated which can be put to your next AES product or directly bank transferred to you to spend on whatever you like!
